ABOUT THE SPEAKER



Soror Paulette Brown is a partner with Locke Lord LLP where she is Chief Diversity Officer and is the Immediate-Past President of the American Bar Association (ABA). She was nominated for the presidency and was later confirmed by the organization's House of Delegates as president-elect in August 2014. *She thus became the first woman of color and third African-American person to be president of the ABA.*

She is a mediator for the United States District Court for the District of New Jersey and was formerly the president of the National Bar Association and the Association of Black Women Lawyers of New Jersey. She was a municipal court judge in Plainfield, New Jersey and has held a variety of leadership positions.

Paulette Brown was educated in Baltimore, earned a B.A. from Howard University (where she was initiated into Alpha Chapter of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc.) and a J.D. from Seton Hall University School of Law.
